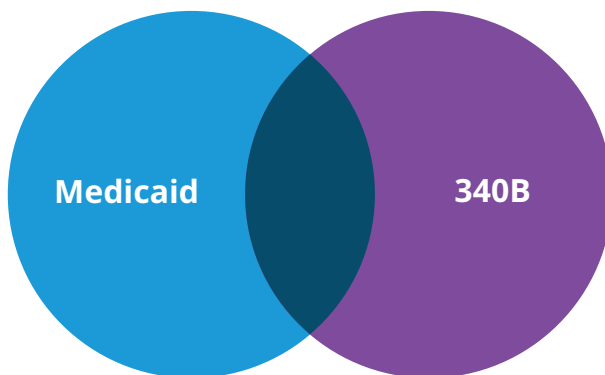

The Challenges at the Intersection of Medicaid and 340B

Since the inception of the 340B drug discount program, State Medicaid programs have needed to navigate challenges at the intersection of Medicaid and 340B.
